Cook Responsibilities:

- 4) Bring prepared food for 300-400 "sample-size" servings
- 5) Bleach or green substitute to mix with water to keep area clean and sanitary
- 6) Attends pre-event venue walk-through and reviews all materials
- 7) 3-weeks in advance of event provides written request for electricity, etc.
- 8) Bring ample amount of serving utensils, large spoons, knives, etc.
- 9) Arrive no later than 3 hours before event begins to park and prepare
- 10) Encourage ticket sales and event support
- 11) Arrange, in advance, ticketing and event day entry for family & friends
- 12) Support our sponsors whenever possible
- 13) Help a fellow brother or neophyte cook stay calm and safe during event
- 14) Return all items issued, clean and break down your area at event's end
- 15) Enjoy the day, the attention and our sincere appreciation for your commitment

Our (Real Men Cook's) Responsibilities:

- 1) Advertise, market, sell sponsorships and help charities earn funds
- 2) Provide your paper goods – sample sized plates or bowls, napkins, etc.
- 3) Issue your plastic table ware; forks, knives, spoons, plastic-disposable gloves
- 4) Provide a supply of aluminum foil and ice
- 5) Provide soap and water for your regular use throughout the event
- 6) Issue chaffing dishes with sterno
- 7) Provide registered cooks with a hand-made event apron & program book
- 8) Place linen or plastic table cloths and skirts for your serving table
- 10) Manage regular garbage removal and ample disposal opportunities
- 11) Provide two (2) complimentary tickets for the guests of your choice to attend
- 12) Make your experience as pleasant and memorable as possible
- 13) Secure and train a volunteer team ready to serve you with a smile
